



## **SOUTH DAKOTA LOTTERY DRAWING GUIDELINES**

### **“Dick Clark’s New Year’s Rockin’ Eve” Powerball 2<sup>nd</sup> Chance Drawing June 15<sup>th</sup> 2019 – September 15<sup>th</sup> 2019**

#### **I. PURPOSE**

These drawing guidelines have been prepared to ensure the prizes awarded for the “Dick Clark’s New Year’s Rockin’ Eve” promotion drawing are determined as impartially and randomly as possible and that the integrity of the South Dakota Lottery is maintained at all times.

The Executive Director of the South Dakota Lottery reserves the right to change and supersede any outlined procedures to handle unforeseen circumstances.

#### **II. GENERAL**

- A. “Dick Clark’s New Year’s Rockin’ Eve” promotion is a second chance drawing in which South Dakota Lottery Players Club members can enter non-winning Powerball tickets for a chance to win a trip for 2 to New York City for New Year’s Eve and a chance to be 2020’s first Millionaire. The drawing will have two winners total, both winners receiving a once-in-a-lifetime trip to New York City’s Times Square for the “New Year’s Rockin’ Eve VIP Experience” and a chance to become the first Powerball millionaire of 2020.
- B. To be eligible for the drawing, the entrant must be a member of the Players Club.
- C. To become eligible for the drawings, players must enter a non-winning Powerball ticket that has not previously been entered for any other Lottery drawing by accessing the Players Club website at <http://lottery.sd.gov/players/login/> or through the official SD Lottery app. Each ticket will receive one entry. Entries will be accepted until the entry cutoff time of 11:59 p.m. CST September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019.
- D. The winners of the “Dick Clark’s New Year’s Rockin’ Eve” promotion drawing will be determined at a publicly held drawing at the Pierre Lottery office in accordance with SDCL Chapter 42-7A, Lottery administrative rules, and these “Dick Clark’s New Year’s Rockin’ Eve” Drawing Guidelines. The Executive Director shall have the discretion to alter the date, time and location of the Prize Drawing. The odds of an entrant being selected as a “Dick Clark’s New Year’s Rockin’ Eve” Drawing winner will be determined by the number of entries submitted.



- E. Two (2) Winners and 10 (10) alternates will be randomly selected during the drawing. Winners will have 10 days from the date they are notified of their win to submit their confirmation information to receive their prize; should that deadline not be met, the prize will revert to the next alternate.
- F. Should the security and integrity of the Players Club webpage be comprised by technological intrusion or other like actions, the promotion will be suspended until such time as said security has been reinstated and verified.
- G. In the event that the South Dakota Lottery is unable to conduct the drawing, due to technological issues or other like circumstances, the Multi-State Lottery Association (MUSL) has been authorized to perform the drawing in a back-up capacity, utilizing the procedures and processes contained in these guidelines.

### **III. PRIZE TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

- A. Winner must travel on or about December 29, 2019, and January 1, 2020, to participate in the Trip Prize. If Winner is unable to or will not travel on the dates and times selected by Lottery, the selected Winner will forfeit the Trip Prize, and another Winner will be selected from among eligible entries received, time permitting. If Winner resides fewer than two hundred fifty (250) miles from New York City, NY, Prize Provider, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to provide ground transportation in lieu of airline transportation. Winner and guest must travel on same itinerary.
- B. All expenses involved with or related to the Trip Prize not specifically included in the description of the Trip Prize, including, without limitation, ground transportation, transfers, additional hotel amenities (i.e., spa services, internet access, phone calls, laundry services), fees and gratuities, airline change fees, airline premium seat fees, airline baggage fees (both checked and carry on), and personal expenses such as laundry, valet service, photos, souvenirs, and other incidentals, are the responsibility of Winner and guest. Winner will be required to submit a valid major credit card to the hotel to cover all expenses not specifically awarded as part of the Trip Prize. Travel and hotel accommodations are subject to availability.
- C. The date and location of any of the events or activities included in the Trip Prize (individually/collectively, "Event(s)") may be subject to change. Prize Provider not responsible if any Event is delayed, postponed, or cancelled for any reason, in whole or in part, and in such event, Prize Provider's only obligation is to award the other elements of the Trip Prize. No compensation will be paid in lieu of any cancelled Event or any other element of the Trip Prize.



- D. Winner and his or her guest must comply with all of the rules and regulations of the venues where the Events are held. Winner acknowledges that if Winner and/or his or her guest behaves in a disorderly or disruptive manner or with intent to annoy, abuse, threaten, or harass any other person at any Event, Winner and/or his or her guest may be removed from the venue or denied entry (as determined by Prize Provider or its designee(s) in their sole and absolute discretion). By accepting any ticketed portion of the Trip Prize, Winner agrees to abide by any terms, conditions, and restrictions provided by the ticket. Lost, mutilated, or stolen tickets, vouchers, certificates, or pre-paid gift cards will not be replaced.
- E. No prize element substitution, cash substitution, assignment, or transfer of the Trip Prize or any elements thereof is permitted. Any unused elements of the Trip Prize will be forfeited, will not be redeemable for cash, and may not reduce the prize value awarded for tax purposes. Notwithstanding the foregoing:
1. If Winner misses his or her flight, reasonable efforts will be used to reschedule the flight at Winner's expense. If the flight is not able to be rescheduled in a reasonable time for Winner's participation in the Events, (i) Winner shall forfeit and not participate in the travel portion of the Trip Prize, including the Events; (ii) Winner will still receive the Two Hundred Fifty (\$250) spending money portion of the Trip Prize (less any tax withholdings and any outstanding debt setoff, if applicable); and (iii) Winner will remain eligible for the \$1 Million Prize drawing.
  2. If Winner is unable to travel in connection with the Trip Prize for any reason after tickets have been booked, (i) Winner shall forfeit and not participate in the travel portion of the Trip Prize, including the Events; (ii) Winner will still receive the Two Hundred Fifty (\$250) spending money portion of the Trip Prize (less any tax withholdings and any outstanding debt setoff, if applicable); and (iii) Winner will remain eligible for the \$1 Million Prize drawing.
  3. If Winner fails to attend the Event at which the \$1 Million prize drawing occurs, Winner will remain eligible for the \$1 Million Prize drawing.
- F. In any of the foregoing events, a proxy may be appointed to accept the \$1 Million Prize on Winner's behalf at the time of the drawing; however, in such event, Winner will still receive the \$1 Million Prize (less any tax withholdings and outstanding debt setoff, if applicable).
- G. Winners who do not elect to take a guest, or whose guest, for any reason, does not actually take the trip, are still subject to the full amount of any taxes due on the total value of the Trip Prize.



#### **IV. RESPONSIBILITIES**

##### **A. DRAWING MANAGER** - The Drawing Manager shall:

1. Oversee the official Drawer in the selection of the two (2) winners and ten (10) alternates.
2. Compile materials necessary to conduct the drawing (drawing certifications, drawing checklist, winner form, DVR, and CDs).
3. With the Drawing Security Officer, prepare the drawing site.
4. With the Drawing Auditor and Drawing Security Officer, examine the Random Number Generator (RNG) thirty (30) minutes prior to the commencement of the drawing and within thirty (30) minutes after the drawing.
5. Explain the “Dick Clark’s New Year’s Rockin’ Eve” Drawing procedures to the public.
6. Conduct the drawing in accordance with these Drawing Guidelines.
7. Compile a list showing the winning entrants and alternate entrants from the drawing.
8. Along with the Drawing Security Officer, secure an electronic copy of a listing of all tickets entered from BIT (Bureau of Information and Telecommunications) before the official drawing to retain with the official drawing documents.

##### **B. DRAWING SECURITY OFFICER** - The Drawing Security Officer shall:

1. Arrange for an Auditor to be present at the drawing.
2. With the Drawing Manager, prepare the drawing site.
3. With the Drawing Auditor and Drawing Manager, examine the Random Number Generator (RNG) thirty (30) minutes prior to the commencement of the drawing and within thirty (30) minutes after the drawing.
4. Maintain physical security over the drawing site during the drawing.
5. Verify that the DVR is functioning properly.



6. Ensure that the drawing is recorded in its entirety and that after the drawing the recording is secured in a safe place.
7. Participate in the drawing as described in these Drawing Guidelines.
8. Validate the entries to make sure they are valid entries before the winners are declared.
9. Along with the Drawing Manager, secure an electronic copy of all tickets entered from BIT before the official drawing to retain with the official drawing documents.

**C. DRAWING AUDITOR** - The Drawing Auditor shall:

1. Observe all aspects of the drawing and oversee, to a practical extent, that all rules, regulations and procedures are followed. In the event a rule, regulation or procedure is not followed, the Drawing Auditor shall bring it to the attention of the Drawing Manager.
2. With the Drawing Manager and Drawing Security Officer, examine the Random Number Generator (RNG) thirty (30) minutes prior to the commencement of the drawing and within thirty (30) minutes after the drawing.
3. Verify the names and numbers of the winners and alternates with the numbers chosen by the random number generator and the list provided with BIT coincide. Ticket validation will be verified through the Scientific Games International Keyed Dual Security program.
4. Forward the Drawing Auditor's report to the Drawing Manager and send a copy to the Executive Director within four (4) working days following the scheduled drawing.

**D. DRAWER** - The Drawing Drawer:

1. Must be at least eighteen years of age.
2. May be an employee of the South Dakota Lottery and may be the Drawing Manager.
3. Must draw the winning entries in accordance with these drawing guidelines.

**V. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

- A. Entrants must be at least eighteen (18) years old to participate and win a prize.



- B. Persons may enter up to 40 *Powerball* tickets per day on the Players Club webpage or Lottery mobile app. Each ticket may only be entered once. An attempt to submit an entry that has already been submitted will generate an error message informing the player that the entry has already been submitted and may not be resubmitted. The eligibility of the winning entry shall be determined by the Lottery after the drawing through a verification process. In the unlikely event of duplicate winning entries, the Lottery shall employ investigative measures to determine by activation, sell and entry date of ticket, and other verifiable means the validity of the entries to declare a single winning entry.
- C. Participation shall be limited to persons whose eligible entries are received on the Players Club webpage by 11:59 p.m. CST September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019.
- D. The South Dakota Lottery will not be responsible for data entry errors from the entrants. The risk of loss for the electronic non-delivery, late delivery or failure of receipt for ticket information entered electronically in the promotion remains with the entrant, regardless of the cause of transmission failure.
- E. Entries are ineligible if:
  - 1. The Lottery is unable to determine the owner of the entry.
  - 2. Is received after the ending entry date.
  - 3. Any ticket is shown to be of stolen status, unissued, counterfeit in whole or in part, mis-registered, defective, printed or produced in error, multiple printed, or fails any of the Lottery's confidential validation tests.
  - 4. If the entry/account does not have a valid mailing address.

## VI. METHOD OF PROCESSING ENTRIES

- A. All entries must be received through the Players Club website at <http://lottery.sd.gov/players/login/> or through the official South Dakota Lottery App. Once an entry has been successfully submitted into a 2<sup>nd</sup> Chance promotion, it is no longer eligible to be entered into any other 2<sup>nd</sup> Chance promotion.
- B. Entries received via internet will be secured in a database maintained by BIT (Bureau of Information and Telecommunications) and Lottery personnel for the purpose of conducting the drawing or obtaining information necessary to assist drawing entrants. BIT provides a number of internal security measures to ensure that online entries are secure. Data collected in the course of the promotion is stored on secure servers within a guarded limited access hosting facility and access to data



is protected by a variety of security products. The Director of Security for the South Dakota Lottery has been made aware of these security procedures and has deemed them acceptable for the purposes of this drawing.

- C. Internet entries are processed 24 hours a day, seven days a week, from the date and time the promotion begins until the final deadline of the final drawing for which entries are eligible to be submitted. Each entry record contains a date stamp to indicate when it was submitted by the entrant.
- D. Each internet entry will be validated by Lottery Security, if selected.
- E. All internet-generated entries are retained in the entry database for the duration of the promotion, regardless of whether or not they are selected in the drawing, to ensure that any entry cannot be submitted more than one time during the course of the promotion.

## VII. DRAWING PROCEDURES

- A. The Drawing Manager, Drawing Security Officer, and Drawing Auditor shall conduct the “Dick Clark’s New Year’s Rockin’ Eve” promotion Drawing from all the eligible entries.
- B. The Drawing Manager, in the presence of the Drawing Security Officer and the Drawing Auditor, shall conduct the drawing using the following process:
  - Check Seals on the RNG Draw Machine
  - Boot up RNG Draw Machine
  - Drawing Manager Logs in to RNG Draw Machine
  - Enter Name of Drawing Security Manager
  - Enter Game Parameters

If 10 valid winners are not verified after the first 10 entries selected, the Lottery will continue to work through the list in the order provided on the printed report from the RNG Draw Machine until a valid non-winning entry is verified. Entry verification will be processed through Scientific Games Keyed Dual Security program by the Security Department.

Print Report

Log off RNG Draw Machine

The Drawing Security Officer shall match the fifteen winning entries selected by the RNG to the entries' corresponding numbers from the list of entrants from the LT08 database. The Drawing Security Officer shall then match the next nine alternate winning entries to be used in the event that an unofficial winning entry is declared ineligible, that Lottery officials are unable to locate the winning player, or that any of the winners are unable to collect the prize. If valid winners are not verified after the first 10 entries, the Lottery will continue to work through the list in the order provided on the printed report from the RNG Draw Machine until a valid non-winning entry is verified.

C. The Drawing Security Officer shall record the "Dick Clark's New Year's Rockin' Eve" promotion Drawing winners' names onto an official results form, which will then be





copied and the copy given to the Director of Advertising and Public Relations immediately following the conclusion of the drawing.

- D. The Drawing Manager, by 5 p.m. CST of the second working day following the completion of the “Dick Clark’s New Year’s Rockin’ Eve” Drawing, shall file with the Executive Director a list of the winners and alternates drawn and the following certifications:
1. Certification by the Drawing Manager that the “Dick Clark’s New Year’s Rockin’ Eve” Drawing was conducted in compliance with SDCL Chapter 42-7A, Lottery administrative rules and these Drawing Guidelines.
  2. Certification by the Drawing Auditor, to the practical extent, that the procedures established in these Drawing Guidelines have been followed and the “Dick Clark’s New Year’s Rockin’ Eve” Drawing was conducted in compliance with SDCL Chapter 42-7A, Lottery administrative rules and these Drawing Guidelines.

#### **VIII. STORAGE, TRANSPORTATION AND SECURITY OF DRAWING EQUIPMENT**

- A. When not in use, the drawing equipment shall be kept in a secured area.
- B. When not in the secured area, the drawing equipment shall be under the control of Lottery security personnel.
- C. Drawing equipment will be moved, serviced, or otherwise handled only by those persons authorized by the Director of Security and Video Lottery or designee.

**STANDARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

These Standard Terms and Conditions set forth on this Exhibit “B” govern the Agreement to which this Exhibit “B” is attached, along with any other exhibits and schedules that may also be attached and agreed by the parties (collectively, the “**Agreement**”). Capitalized but undefined terms used in these Standard Terms will have the meaning first ascribed to them in the Agreement



***Licensing for  
South Dakota Lottery “Dick Clark’s New Year’s Rockin’ Eve”  
Promotion Drawing***

**I. LICENSE**

- A. Subject to Paragraph 2.1 below, as part of the Producer Obligations, Producer grants Partner a non-exclusive, non-transferable, royalty-free license to use and display the names, logos, trademarks, and artwork of the Program (collectively, “Program Marks”) and the Promotion Materials in connection with the execution of the Promotion and the advertising, publicity, and marketing thereof in any and all media, now known or hereafter devised, throughout the Territory during the Promotion Period.
- B. Subject to Paragraph 2.2. below, as part of the Partner Obligations, Partner hereby grants Producer a non-exclusive, royalty-free license to use and display Partner’s name, logos, trademarks, and artwork (“Partner Marks”) and such other materials as Partner may supply and approve for use (e.g., photographs, images) in connection with the execution, of the Promotion and the advertising, publicity, and marketing thereof in any and all media, now known or hereafter devised, throughout the Territory during the Term and if and as applicable, in and in connection with the Program (and the series or franchise of which it is a part) and the advertising, marketing, and promotion thereof in any and all media, known and unknown, throughout the universe in perpetuity.

**II. APPROVALS**

- A. All uses of the Program Marks and Promotion Materials and all elements of the Promotion must be approved by Producer (such approval not to be unreasonably withheld or delayed) in writing (email to suffice) prior to their final production and use and are subject to any third-party approvals that Producer deems necessary to obtain. In connection therewith, Partner shall submit all creative executions or other artwork, promotional materials, or other materials embodying the Program Marks and/or any changes to the Promotion Materials or new materials created from or using the Promotional Materials to Producer for its prior written approval prior to any use thereof. All submissions to Producer for its approval shall be made in a reasonable time frame for review, and all submissions that are not expressly approved by Producer in writing shall be deemed disapproved. Producer’s approval of any materials hereunder shall not be deemed to be a statement or opinion by Producer that such materials or content comply with any applicable laws, regulations, or rules and shall not abrogate Producer’s representations and warranties hereunder. The Program Marks and/or Promotion Materials may be used in the Promotion only as and in the form created by or approved by Producer and shall not be changed in any manner



without Producer's prior written consent.

- B. All uses of the Partner Marks must be approved by Partner (such not to be unreasonably withheld or delayed) in writing (email to suffice) prior to their final production and use and are subject to any third-party approvals that Partner deems necessary to obtain. In connection therewith, Producer shall submit all creative executions or other artwork, promotional materials, or other materials embodying the Partner Marks to Partner for its prior written approval prior to any use thereof. All submissions to Partner for its approval shall be made in a reasonable timeframe for review (subject to Producer's production exigencies), and all submissions that are not expressly disapproved by Partner in writing (email shall suffice) shall be deemed approved. Partner's approval of any materials hereunder shall not be deemed to be a statement or opinion by Partner that such materials or content comply with any applicable laws, regulations, or rules and shall not abrogate Partner's representations and warranties hereunder.

### **III. REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES**

- A. Each party hereto represents and warrants that (i) it has all necessary rights, power, and authority to enter into this Agreement, to perform the acts required of it hereunder, and to grant the rights granted hereunder; (ii) it is not subject to any restrictive obligations imposed by any third party or any court, government, or legislative authority that would materially interfere with its performance under this Agreement; (iii) any information or materials produced and/or provided by such party hereunder or permissions secured by such party hereunder, directly or through its designee, will not violate or infringe upon the rights of any third party (including, without limitation, intellectual property rights); and (iv) it will comply, at its own expense, with all applicable laws, regulations, codes, and other requirements relating to the fulfillment of its obligations hereunder.

### **IV. FORCE MAJEURE**

- A. If Producer is prevented from or interfered with in any manner whatsoever in fully performing any of its obligations (including its ability to conduct all or a portion of the Program or elements of the Trip Prize) hereunder, by reason of any present or future law, regulation, or order, act of God, earthquake, flood, fire, epidemic, accident, explosion, casualty, labor controversy (including, but not limited to, threatened or actual lockout, boycott, or strike), riot, civil disturbance, war or armed conflict, act or threat of terrorism, delay of a common carrier, or by reason of any other cause(s) beyond the control of Producer, then Producer's failure or inability to perform such affected obligations shall not be deemed a breach of this Agreement nor shall it create any liability to Partner.

### **V. NO INJECTIVE RELIEF**



- A. In the event of a breach of this Agreement by Producer, Partner's sole remedy shall be an action at law for damages, and Partner irrevocably waives any right to seek and/or obtain equitable or injunctive relief preventing or interfering with the production, distribution, advertising, promotion, or other exploitation of the Program.

## **VI. RELATIONSHIP OF PARTIES**

- A. The parties to this Agreement are independent contractors. Neither party is an agent, representative, or partner of the other party nor shall have any right, power, or authority to enter into any agreement for or on behalf of, or incur any obligation or liability of, or to otherwise bind, the other party. This Agreement shall not be interpreted or construed to create an agency, joint venture, or partnership between the parties.

## **VII. GENERAL**

- A. This Agreement may not be modified or amended except in a writing signed by the parties hereto. Partner may not assign or transfer this Agreement without the written consent of Producer. A waiver by either party of any term or condition of this Agreement in any instance shall not be deemed or construed as a waiver of such term or condition for the future or of any subsequent breach thereof. If any provision of this Agreement is determined by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unenforceable, such determination shall not affect any other provision hereof, and the unenforceable provision shall be replaced by an enforceable provision that most closely meets the commercial intent of the parties. This Agreement shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the State of California applicable to agreements to be performed entirely therein, including all matters of construction, validity, and performance, without regard to principles of conflicts of law. Each party irrevocably consents and agrees to the exclusive jurisdiction of the state and federal courts located in the venue of the non-suing party.
