REMINDER: QUARTERLY LICENSING RENEWALS

With another quarter in the books, we remind you that Video Lottery licensing renewals for the months of July through September were due Sept. 30. If you have not submitted your \$100 renewal fee along with the form, please do so as soon as possible. Failure to do so could result in machines being disabled.

Video Lottery licensing renewals for the next quarter were distributed last week. Please ensure that the purple form is completed on both sides. If you have not completed fingerprint cards since July 2017, these will also be included in your packet. Your local sheriff's office can assist you in completing these cards.

Please remember to submit your renewals to the Lottery office by Dec. 21, 2018.

**DON'T FORGET YOUR
MAINTENANCE LOG
BOOKS**

Please remember that operators are required to maintain a log for maintenance of all video lottery machines. The log book should be kept in each machine within the main cabinet access area.



Each person, including lottery personal, DPS inspectors, or any establishment staff or tech, who has access to the internal space of the machine must sign the log book and provide date of entry, mechanical meter readings and a list of areas inspected or repaired. These maintenance logs must can be obtained through the Lottery. If you need additional log books please call 773-5770 and request some. Log books must be retained by operators for three years since the date of the last entry.

If you need to put a new log book in the machine please leave the old one inside until the inspector has completed the next inspection on the machine. This will help them identify entries into the VLT since their last inspection.

Please remember that maintenance logs must be made available if the Lottery requests them.

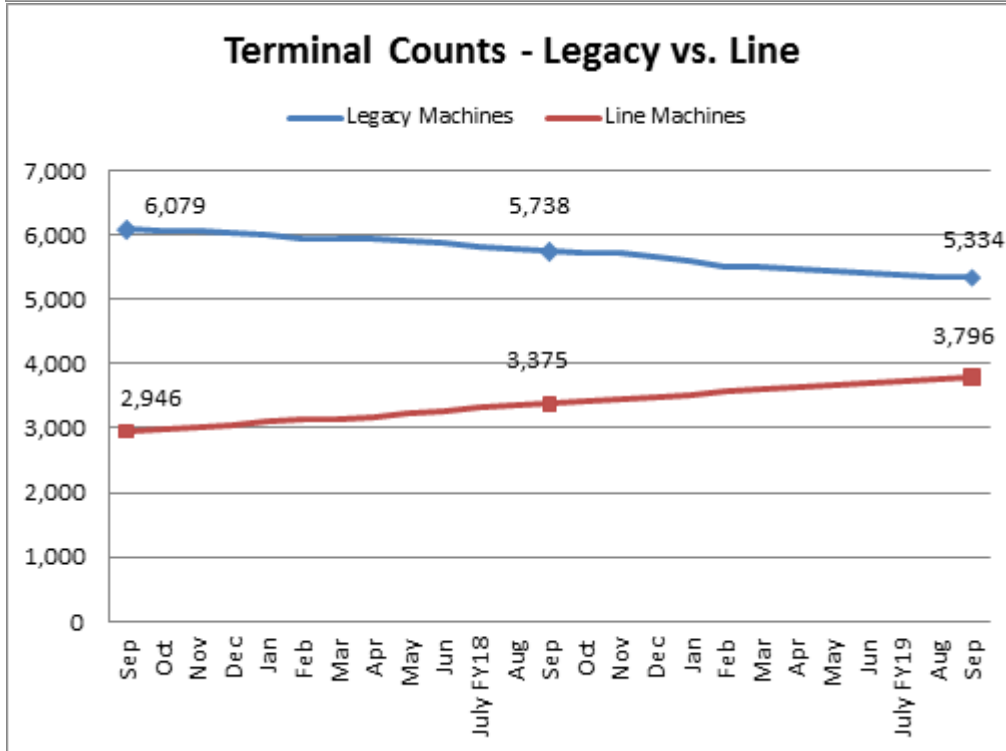
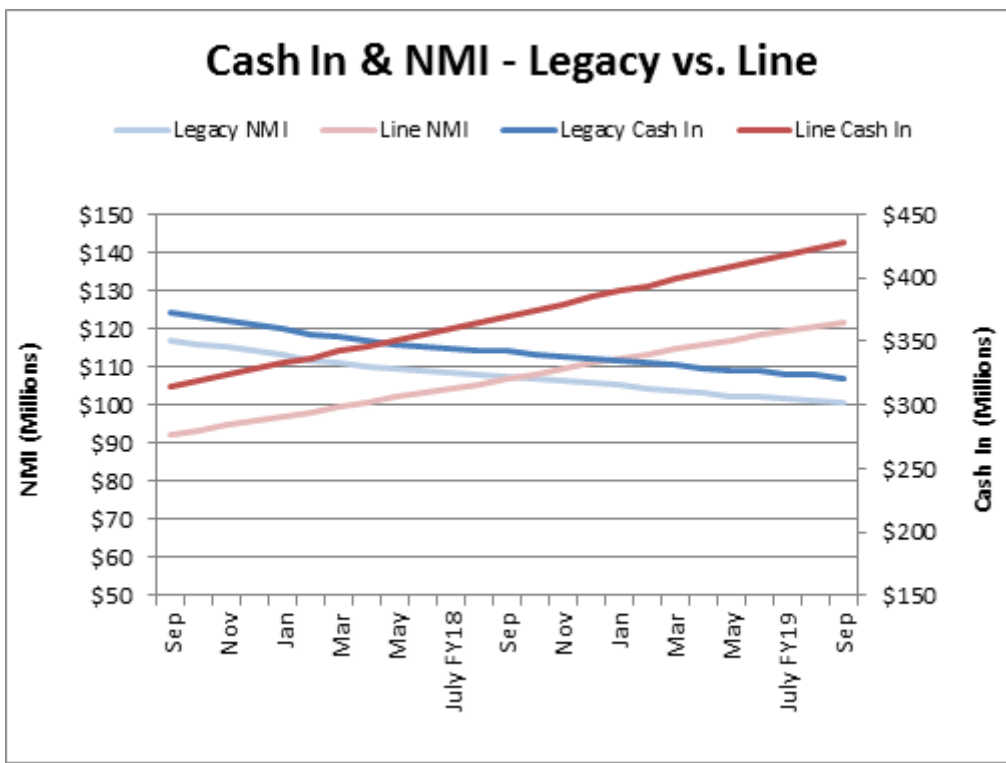
